ITEM FOR DIRECTOR'S LOG

The Administrator of the Federal Civil Defense Administration has written the Secretary of the IAC, under date of 18 April, respecting the report of a panel of scientific consultants on the subject of unidentified flying objects. This report was furnished FCDA under letter of 13 March pursuant to IAC-D-67 (18 February). Administrator Petersen reports his interest in the subject and suggests that a conference be arranged for a full discussion on a mutually satisfactory date.

The correspondence has been referred to OSI, the Office initiating the original report. OSI will work-out-arrangements with FCDA, and FCDA will provide assistance which may be provided by CIA.
